VOCAL TASK!



After exploring your use of vocal techniques in different theatrical styles, you will be presenting a children's story book in the form of a rap.

This rap will be shared with the St Hilda's marketing team for consideration for online inclusion.

STEP 1:

Choose your story

From the books provided. The story must use rhyming language and have a good sense of rhythm in the text.

STEP 2:

Read your story

- Look at the language used
- Identify what rhythm is best for performance
- Look at what words need to be emphasized to make the story clear to an audience

STEP 3:

Choose your backing track

From the music provided in the file on TEAMS. Consider what feeling the story has when you choose the backing music.

STEP 4:

Rehearse

Figure out how you'll match the words to the beat of the music and rehearse.

 If you want to add a small sung section as a riff, use the important emphasized words you identified in step 2.

STEP 5: Perform!

There are two options for this –

- a) Perform your rap live over your backing track with or without your book, a ppt or what you choose.
- b) Record your rap as a music video and present
